



Handy Reference for Mature Bull Elk Measurements and Trophy Identification







Field Judging Rules to Identify a PY Bull Elk

- 1. The inside spread must be 30" or greater between the main beams.
- 2. The bull must have at least five points on each antler to make the book and six points will greatly increase your odds.
- 3. Rear points should extend past the ribcage when the head is up and parallel with the rest of his body.
- 4. The antlers should extend at least as far above the head as that same distance between brisket to shoulder.
